Ribbit is asking audience a riddle? Audience has to find the animal!

**Kids will just love the song at the end of the episode,
in tribute to today's animal.**



As Ribbit gives clues: two ears, four legs, a tail, etc. an absurd and hilarious "animal" character will take shape on the screen. Don't let yourself be tricked by the picture on the screen!

Images play word games, attempting. The game's incongruous combinations work just like red herrings to lead viewers astray. The cat's whiskers are really a corporal's moustache, the rooster has bat's wings, that "dragon's tail" belongs to a crocodile, and that raccoon is a super hero, etc.

At the end of each riddle, the animal will turn into its real shape and dance to a quick song. Ribbit will then come back for a second riddle in an original manner. E.g.: "Let's stop in Africa this time! Just listen to this riddle".
